

Making S&P Graspable: Workshop on Tangible Privacy and Security Interfaces

This workshop brings together, for the first time, researchers and developers from diverse human-centered security domains - such as authentication, education, training, access control, inclusive security, awareness, warnings, privacy in the Internet of Things, and privacy online - who are interested in designing and developing *tangible (i.e., physical) user interfaces*.

We welcome submissions that describe a *vision for a tangible privacy and security interface (TaPSI) or present artifacts or empirical contributions relevant to this topic*. We specifically encourage authors to discuss the future of TaPSI in their submissions. Authors can choose between submitting a position paper (2-4 pages), a demo (2-4 pages), or a video (2-3 min with a 1-2 page written abstract). Authors of accepted submissions will get the opportunity to revise them before they are published as part of the workshop proceedings on ArXiv.
